PROGRAMS

WENTZ RESEARCH SCHOLARS PROGRAM

okla.st/wentzscholar

- Must have completed a minimum of 12 hours at OSU in any discipline
- Propose an independent research project under the guidance of a faculty mentor
- \$4500 scholarship

PURDIE RESEARCH SCHOLARS PROGRAM

okla.st/purdiescholar

- Must have completed a minimum of 12 hours at OSU
- · For students in geology, chemistry or physics
- \$6500 scholarship

NIBLACK RESEARCH SCHOLARS PROGRAM

okla.st/niblackscholar

- Must have completed a minimum of 28 hours at OSU
- For lab-based STEM disciplines
- Research takes place over the Fall, Spring and Summer semesters
- \$8000 scholarship

OK-LSAMP

okla.st/oklsamp

- NSF-funded consortium aimed at increasing participation of students from under-represented populations in STEM
- Up to \$2000 per semester
- Apply any time

MCNAIR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

okla.st/mcnairscholar

- Federally-funded TRIO program providing guidance to under-represented students in preparation for graduate school
- \$2800 stipend

UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM

- Any undergraduate student can present their research at this annual symposium
- Held in April every year

UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH SCHOLAR TRANSCRIPT DESIGNATION

okla.st/transcriptdesignation

A one-time transcript designation for students who
were involved in research for at least two semesters
and either published a paper in a peer-reviewed journal
or presented at a state, regional or national conference.
