

Dr. Jeremy Baham is the Associate/Assistant Vice President for Student Affairs at Mississippi State University since 2016. In this role he has direct oversight of University Health Services, Longest Student Health Center, the Student Counseling Center, the Office of Student Well-Being, University Recreation, the Office of Survivor Support, the Disability Resource Center and the Center for America's Veterans.
