

Dr. Bill Stackman has spent his career in student affairs, most recently as the Dean of Students at Harvard University Graduate School of Arts and Science. He previously served for Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and Dean at the University of Missouri, and for seven years as the Associate Vice President for Student Services at the University of Notre Dame.

Stackman has held leadership positions at a number of institutions, including Director of Student Activities at Texas A&M University, Dean of Student Affairs at Rhodes College, Associate Dean and Dean of Students at Oberlin College, Director of Student Activities/Mayer Campus Center at Tufts University, Associate Director of the Illini Union and Program Director at the University of Illinois, and Associate Director of Student Activities at Temple University.

Dr. Stackman earned his doctorate at Boston University in Leadership, Administration, and Policy Studies. He also holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Kentucky in Parks and Recreation, a master's degree from the University of Missouri-Columbia in Parks and Recreation Administration, a master's degree from West Virginia University in Higher Education Administration, a master's degree from the University of Missouri-Columbia in Positive Coaching, and a master's degree from the University of Missouri in Social Work. He is currently completing a master's degree in Psychology at Harvard University.
