Melinda A. Cro, Ph.D. (PhD Romance Languages, The University of Georgia) is Associate Dean of Student Success, Engagement & Undergraduate Studies in the College of Arts and Sciences and Professor of Modern Languages at Kansas State University. She has served in successive leadership roles throughout her time at K-State, including as Graduate Program Director and Department Head of Modern Languages.

In her current role, she oversees strategic enrollment management efforts and coordinates student success initiatives across the College. A digital humanist and early modernist, Cro's research focuses on two areas: (1) the development of the novel and representations of nature in the 16th-18th centuries and (2) digital pedagogy and best practices in second language pedagogy.
